A knowledge of Anatomy is indispensable for all who wish to portray the human figure whether by the brush or the modelling tool.

### PAINTING, DRAWING AND MODELLING IN CLAY.

Arrangements have been made with Mr. Raniero Cali, a clever Artist who has studied in Rome, to teach Drawing and Painting in Oils or Water Colours, and with Mr. F. S. Sciortino, the well known Sculptor who has likewise studied in Rome, to teach Modelling in Clay.

Classes will be held in Valletta, on Tuesdays and Fridays from 3.30 to 5 p.m. The locality will be communicated later. Classes will also be held at Sliema on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 3.30 to 5 p.m. at Chiswick House School, 9 Strada Ridolfo, kindly lent by Miss Yabsley.

The fee is fixed at 8/- for 4 lessons per month, and at 12/- for 8 lessons per month for either Painting or Modelling in Clay, Students providing their own materials.

Arrangements will be made for occasional meetings in the country for Landscape sketching from Nature.
